

Liberals' elective surgery funding boost a welcome step in the right direction

Health Consumers Tasmania (HCT) provides health consumer advocacy on behalf of Tasmanians and has a community of interest of over 650 people right around the State.

HCT CEO, Bruce Levett, has welcomed today's announcement that if re-elected, the Liberals will invest more than \$150 million into elective surgery.

"The statistics for Tasmania are concerning, with only 56 per cent of Tasmanians receiving elective surgery within the clinically recommended timeframes," Mr Levett said.
